ANTARCTIC LOGISTICS & EXPEDITIONS

NAME OF INTERCONTINENTAL AIRCRAFT: Ilyushin IL-76TD, Kazakhstan registry.

NUMBER OF PASSENGERS: A maximum of 60 passengers on each of twelve inbound flights, 9 staff and crew on each flight. A total of 195 passengers for the season are anticipated. Fifteen ground-based expedition staff and 45 operations staff will facilitate activities on-Continent.

ITINERARY: A number of flights to and within Antarctica are planned, according to the following itinerary. Equipment to be used within Antarctica include one De Havilland DHC-6 Twin Otter and one Douglas DC3-TP67 aircraft, *inter alia*, for passenger transport, logistic and medivac support. All expeditions depart from and return to Punta Arenas via base camp at Patriot Hills. Site visits may vary depending on weather and ice conditions.
