Funding for existing AGEP projects will continue in Fiscal Year 2010 as currently scheduled. Details concerning changes in the AGEP portion of the solicitation will be announced in a timely fashion.

Current AGEP grantees may submit **Innovation through Institutional Integration (I3)** proposals.
