

## Impact on Existing Solicitations

Proposers are advised that NSF may be modifying the requirements contained in existing solicitations to provide temporary guidance for proposals submitted or due during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Links to the impacted solicitations and a brief description of the change(s) are detailed below. Additional solicitations may be added to the list, so proposers are strongly encouraged to check [NSF's website](#) regularly. **Requirements for published program solicitations that do not appear on the list below remain unchanged.**

18-515	<a href="#">Innovation Corps – National Innovation Network Teams Program (I-Corps Teams)</a>	Includes temporary guidance to proposers and active grantees regarding budgeted travel and customer discovery activities and extensions for period of performance.
18-584	<a href="#">SBE Postdoctoral Research Fellowships (SPRF)</a>	The SPRF program will be accepting COVID-19 related supplement requests to extend the fellowship tenure of active awardees with start dates through January 1, 2020.
20-545	<a href="#">Small Business Innovation Research Program Phase II (SBIR Phase II)</a>	Temporarily extends the SBIR Phase II solicitation's eligibility criteria to allow current Phase I grantees more time to submit their Phase II proposals.
20-546	<a href="#">Small Business Technology Transfer Program Phase II (STTR Phase II)</a>	Temporarily extends the STTR Phase II solicitation's eligibility criteria to allow current Phase I grantees more time to submit their Phase II proposals.
20-562	<a href="#">Civic Innovation Challenge</a>	Notifies proposers about the issuance of a new Dear Colleague Letter ( <a href="#">NSF 20-100</a> ) that clarifies the additional support and focus areas of the program.
