The National Institute of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice, will implement the RPPR as a pdf submission from grantees into OJP's Grant Management System (GMS) through which all of NIJ's grants are awarded and managed. NIJ will initiate the RPPR as the format for progress reporting requirements; thus, grantees will incur no increase in reporting burden. NIJ will use the RPPR to collect progress reports and performance data on all research and research-related awards, including those to institutions of higher education, non-profit organizations and for-profit organizations. Incorporation of the RPPR within GMS will streamline and standardize grant progress reporting for ! all grantees. NIJ anticipates full implementation for the collection of the required RPPR data by the end of Fiscal Year 2011 (i.e., September 30, 2011).
