The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), will implement the Research Performance Progress Report (RPPR) as a Portable Document Format (pdf) file submission from award recipients into OJP's Grants Management System (GMS), through which all grants are awarded and managed. OJP will initiate the RPPR as the format for progress reporting requirements and to collect performance data for research and research-related awards (including those to institutions of higher education, non-profit organizations and for-profit organizations); thus, recipients will incur no increase in reporting burden. Incorporation of the RPPR into GMS will streamline and standardize grant progress reporting for all recipients. OJP anticipates full implementation for the collection of the required RPPR data by September 30, 2011.
