



# Innovation in Two-Year College STEM Education (ITYC) Program

ITYC is a new NSF program that accelerates the impact of inclusive and evidence-based practices in [undergraduate STEM education at two-year colleges](#) across the country.



The ITYC program invites proposals to two [tracks](#):

Track 1: A Focus on the Academic Experiences of Two-Year College Students

Track 2: Leveraging Institutional Strengths and Innovation

The deadline for all tracks is [December 13, 2023](#), and the second Wednesday in December annually thereafter.

Planning proposals for both tracks are accepted at any time. Conference and workshop proposals are accepted at any time.



## Eligibility

Two-year colleges of higher education that offer degrees in STEM must be the lead organization on a proposal. Four-year institutions and professional organizations may partner with a two-year college as a subaward or collaborator.

Projects may be in any discipline that is currently supported by NSF funding.
