


Recruit and screen applicants for your NSF award with ETAP!

The National Science Foundation
(NSF) Education and Training
Application (ETAP) is a secure
online platform that connects
applicants to NSF-funded
Opportunities by providing you—Pls and
Co-Pls of NSF awards—a flexible and
customizable common application system.



You can create Opportunities for applicants using a **common application** system that includes collection of basic information on applicants through a common registration form. Whether you want your Opportunity to be publicly advertised to recruit applicants nationally or recruit students by invitation only, ETAP can help you.

## Some of the benefits of ETAP for PIs include:

- Flexible and customizable application set-up, enabling you to create your own application questions, request references or transcripts, and more!
- Bulk actions allowing you to efficiently download application materials or enter admissions decisions for multiple applicants at a time
- Tools for collaboration, so you can assemble teams and delegate tasks to help you manage your Opportunity
- Ready-made reports that provide descriptive statistics about your applicants and participants and how they compare to applicants and participants in other Opportunities. You can also access raw data to support your own analysis.
- **User support,** including answers to Frequently Asked Questions, video resources, and a Help Desk
- Access to a National pool of diverse and qualified applicants
- Reduced burden on applicants by offering a streamlined application process that saves time when applying to multiple Opportunities



- Basic information, like name, pronouns, date of birth, and email address
- Demographic information and family background, like race/ethnicity, sex and gender information, veteran and disability status, Pell grant status, and parental education and occupation
- Educational background, including degrees obtained and postsecondary enrollment status
- Questions about research and work experience and previous NSF program participation

For all questions, applicants have the option to select that they do not wish to provide that information

You can apply to Opportunities using a **streamlined application process** that saves time when applying to multiple Opportunities. Fill out a common registration form once and it is ready to use for any Opportunity. If your information changes, simply return to your registration form and update your information at any time.

## Some benefits of ETAP for applicants include:

- A transparent and centralized location for finding a wide variety of NSF-funded Opportunities
- Search tools for locating and saving Opportunities that meet your interests
- The ability to save personal statements, transcripts, and CVs for use in multiple applications
- Letter of recommendation management tools, which send reference requests and track when letters are uploaded
- **User support**, including answers to Frequently Asked Questions, video resources, and a Help Desk
- Mobile friendly design
- Support for applicants with limited internet or other access challenges via Help Desk support
