MPS is pleased to announce the selection of Dr. Jacquelyn Gervay-Hague as the Division Director, Division of Chemistry, Directorate for Mathematical and Physical Sciences. Dr. Gervay-Hague is currently a Professor in the Department of Chemistry at University of California, Davis. She also serves as the Chair of the Department. Dr. Gervay-Hague earned her Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry from University of California, Los Angeles in 1990, and previously held positions at the University of Arizona and a post-doctoral fellowship at Yale University. Her research interests include organic synthesis, chemical biology, carbohydrate chemistry, and molecular recognition processes associated with HIV and cancer, including protein/carbohydrate interactions and enzyme inhibition. Dr. Gervay-Hague is a Fellow of the American Chemical Society and an Associate Editor of the Journal of Organic Chemistry. Dr. Gervay-Hague will begin her appointment at NSF in July 2013.
