

# HOUSE AND SENATE ACTION IN 2017

	CJS Subcommittee Vote	Full Appropriations Committee Vote	FY 2018 Mark	Change from FY 2017 Enacted
House	June 29	July 13	\$7,340M	-\$133M (-2%)
Senate	July 25	July 27	\$7,311M	-\$161M (-2%)

- These amounts were voted on before the recent budget deal raised the spending caps

- Under the new budget caps, on February 12<sup>th</sup> the President recommended that Congress addback \$819 million to NSF's FY 2018 Request bringing it flat to FY 2017
