Dr. John Russell is a 2016-2017 AAAS Science and Technology Policy Fellow at NSF contributing to the Secure and Trustworthy Cyberspace program. His work supported the ASCR Leadership Computing Challenge program, the Energy Science Network and the National Strategic Computing Initiative. Previously, he conducted postdoctoral research at Argonne National Laboratory to explore advanced materials for batteries and catalysis. John received his Ph.D. in chemistry from University of Illinois at Chicago in 2012 and his B.A. with dual majors in chemistry and English literature from Washington University in St. Louis in 2002. John served as a chemical officer in the U.S. Army 2002-2006 with the 10th Mountain Division, and he deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
