The Committee of Visitors (COV) for the Atmosphere Section (AS) of the Division of Atmospheric and Geospace Sciences was held on 7-9 April 2010. Nine (9) scientists, representing the breadth of science of the community, were asked to participate. Among this group were two females, three federal employees, one minority scientist, and one scientist from an HBCU. In accordance with Subchapter 300, over twenty-five percent had not been applicants to the LARS programs in the last five years. The set of institutions with which the potential COV members are affiliated represented a reasonable geographic distribution and mix of public and private institutions. The COV was chaired by Dr. Lonnie Thompson of Ohio State University, a current member of the Advisory Committee for Geosciences. The list was sent to your office for approval.
