

Future Plan 1

- Integration with ReaD (2011)
 - Directory Database of Research and Development Activities (ReaD) is a database service designed to promote cooperation among industry, academia and government. (0.2 million researchers)
 - Researchmap & ReaD will be the largest researcher community in Japan, and 2nd largest in the world
- Integration with WebcatPlus (2011)
 - Providing researchers to organize their bookshelves
