Randolph W. Sawyer is the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Suspension and Debarment Official (SDO) at Headquarters ICE. He is also the Assistant Director for the Suspension and Debarment Division housed within the ICE Office of Acquisition Management. Mr. Sawyer established the ICE Suspension and Debarment Division in May 2008. Prior to his current appointment as the ICE SDO, he was a contracting officer with ICE. He was previously employed by Bechtel National as a contracting officer on the Iraqi Infrastructure Reconstruction Program and the post-Katrina rebuild of Mississippi. Prior to that, he was in private practice as a Certified Financial Planner in San Antonio, Texas.

Mr. Sawyer served in the USAF, both on active duty and as a Reservist. He retired from the USAF Reserve in 2006 as a Major. Active duty assignments include tours as a Titan II ICBM Combat Crew Commander, an Audit Manager with USAF Audit, and an Administrative Contracting Officer with Defense Contract Management Agency with postings in San Antonio, Texas; Houston, Texas; and Baghdad, Iraq.
