Call for Nominations

The National Science Board (NSB) invites nominations for the 2006 NSB Public Service Awards. Established by the NSB in November 1996, the award is presented annually in May to recognize increased public understanding of science or engineering. The awards are given to an individual and a group (company, corporation, or organization). Accomplishments in science and engineering are helpful but not a primary consideration. Members of the U.S. Government are not eligible.
