When completing the requested summary budgetary information below, please keep in mind budgetary norms and limits for the programs at NSF and UKRI:

- **For AHRC-led** proposals the UK costs must be between £50,000 and £1 million.
- **For BBSRC-led** proposals the UK costs may not exceed £1 million (there is no minimum).
- **For ESRC-led** proposals the UK costs must be between £350,000 and £1 million.
- **For NSF-led** proposals where AHRC is the UK funder, a maximum of £350,000 can be requested for UK costs.
- **For NSF-led** proposals where ESRC/BBSRC is the UK funder, a maximum of £1 million can be requested for UK costs.
- **For NSF-led** proposals, please consult with the relevant program(s) for budgetary norms.
- There is no minimum amount for UK contributions where NSF is the Lead Agency.



If your EOI is accepted as falling within the scope of research typically reviewed by the NSF/SBE program as well as fitting with the remit of ESRC, AHRC or BBSRC, you will be invited to submit a full research proposal. We expect that full proposals will be submitted within 12 months of EOI acceptance. If more time is needed for proposal preparation, an additional EOI may be required.

## **Data sharing**

Data is shared between UKRI and SBE to enable the secure and efficient processing of EOIs and full proposals for the US NSF/SBE – UKRI Lead Agency Opportunity. Data shared includes EOIs, proposal attachments, anonymised peer reviews and panel comments. Data is shared via a secure extranet where appropriate. UKRI and SBE are committed to maintaining data confidentiality, protection and privacy and intend to fully abide by their own applicable laws and policies concerning the sharing of data in our collaborative activities.
