



**REVISION OF THE NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUNDATION (NSF)
SMALL BUSINESS INNOVATION RESEARCH (SBIR)/SMALL BUSINESS
TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER (STTR) PHASE II GRANT GENERAL CONDITIONS
(SBIR-II)**

EFFECTIVE MARCH 7, 2014

Effective March 7, 2014, new NSF SBIR/STTR Phase II grants and funding amendments to existing NSF SBIR/STTR Phase II grants will begin referencing and are subject to the *NSF SBIR/STTR Phase II Grant General Conditions (SBIR-II)* dated 03/14. The complete text of the SBIR-II conditions (as well as other NSF grant policy issuances) is available electronically on the NSF website.¹

Unless otherwise noted in a specific article, the *NSF SBIR/STTR Phase II Grant General Conditions* apply to all new NSF SBIR/STTR Phase II grants and funding increments on existing NSF SBIR/STTR Phase II grants awarded on or after March 7, 2014.
