

Professor Sir Roderick Floud is Provost of Gresham College, London - founded in 1597 and the oldest lifelong learning institution in the UK - and chairs the Social Sciences Committee of the European Science Foundation. An economic historian, he has published books and articles on quantitative methods, the history of engineering and the use of information on changing heights and weights for analyzing human living standards; his most recent book, *The Changing Body*, will be published by Cambridge University Press in 2011. He was, for 18 years, head of what became London Metropolitan University and also chaired the representative body, Universities UK, from 2001-2003.
