

Fred Gault is a member of the management team working on the OECD Innovation Strategy to be released in May 2010. For two decades he was responsible for science, technology and innovation statistics at Statistics Canada and during that time he chaired the OECD Working Party on Indicators for the Information Society (1997-2002) and the Working Party of National Experts on Science and Technology Indicators (NESTI) (2002-2008). After Statistics Canada, he joined the International Development Research Centre (IDRC) in Ottawa as a Visiting Fellow and worked on the place of innovation indicators in the development agenda before moving to UNU-MERIT where he manages IDRC funded projects on innovation in Africa.

Currently, he is Professorial Fellow at the United Nations University MERIT in the Netherlands and Professor Extraordinaire at the Tshwane University of Technology in South Africa. His book, *Innovation Strategies for a Global Economy: Development, Implementation, Measurement and Management*, published by Edward Elgar, jointly with IDRC, will be released in July 2010.
