

Steven Ruggles is Regents Professor of History and Population Studies, Distinguished McKnight University Professor, and Director of the Minnesota Population Center at the University of Minnesota. His research interests include historical family demography and development of population data infrastructure. He is Principal Investigator of the Integrated Public Use Microdata Series (IPUMS) projects and has been awarded 45 major grants from NSF and NIH. He received the William J. Goode Award from the Family Section of the American Sociological Association, the Allen Sharlin Award from the Social Science History Association, the Robert J. Lapham Award from the Population Association of America, and the Warren E. Miller Award from the Inter-university Consortium for Political and Social research.
