NOTES: Because of rounding, detail may not add to totals. Tied institutions are listed alphabetically. Only those agencies that had obligations in variables represented by this table appear in the table. This list of minority institutions is based on the definition of "minority institution" found in the Higher Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1067k(3)) and on fall 2010 enrollment data from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) collected by the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). NCES has determined that each academic institution on this list reported an enrollment of a single minority group or a combination of those minority groups that exceeded 50% of its total enrollment. Minority is defined as American Indian or Alaska Native, black (not of Hispanic origin), and Hispanic. This list excludes Asians or Pacific Islanders (IPEDS enrollment data do not disaggregate Pacific Islanders from Asians, although Pacific Islanders are a minority) because Asians are not considered a minority under this program and because studies show that they are not underrepresented in science and engineering.
