NOTES: Only those agencies that had obligations in variables represented by this table appear in table. Tied institutions are listed alphabetically. List of minority institutions is based on the definition of *minority institution* found in Higher Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1067k(3)) and on fall 2009 enrollment data from Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) collected by National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). NCES has determined that each academic institution reported an enrollment of a single minority group or a combination of those minority groups that exceeded 50% of its total enrollment. *Minority* is defined as American Indian/Alaska Native, black (not of Hispanic origin), and Hispanic. List excludes Asians or Pacific Islanders (IPEDS enrollment data do not disaggregate Pacific Islanders from Asians, although Pacific Islanders are a minority) because Asians are not considered a minority under this program and because studies show that they are not underrepresented in science and engineering.
